

Effective Friday, April 8th, masks and proof of vaccination will no longer be required to attend Rollo gatherings. While not required, please be respectful of those who choose to continue wearing a mask.

The Board policy is to implement public health directives pertaining to facilities such as Rollo, and public health has updated their province-wide mandate. We are limited in our capacity and resources to ensure these safety protocols are followed and we are not set up to monitor compliance. We are relying on each person to do their part.

As recommended by Public Health, Rollo is returning to its communicable diseases safety protocols listed below.

NOTE: These protocols reduce but do not eliminate the risk of COVID-19.

ROLLO SAFETY PROTOCOLS:

- 1) It is recommended you complete the B.C. Health self-assessment tool found here: <https://bc.thrive.health/covid19/en> . This self-assessment should be repeated if anything changes (symptoms, travel, exposure to infected individuals, etc.) and even if nothing changes, it is recommended you retake this self-assessment often.
- 2) Do not attend Rollo if you are not feeling well.
- 3) Use the provided hand sanitizer on entering and leaving the building.
- 4) Remember to sneeze and/or cough into your elbow.
- 5) While wearing a mask is no longer required at Rollo, please respect the decisions of those who choose to continue to mask.
- 6) Open windows and doors to promote air circulation if weather conditions permit. If conditions do not permit opening doors and windows, then operate the HEPA air purifier at a low fan setting while attending Rollo and upon leaving, turn the fan to a higher setting for a 1 or 2 hour timed cycle.
- 7) Disinfect all contact surfaces after attending a Rollo activity using the alcohol disinfectant that is provided. Designate one person to oversee the sanitization protocol for each session.
- 8) Wash your hands frequently.
- 9) Leave 3 or 4 tables set up in the large room, and no tables set up and in the small room. All chairs should be stacked on the dollies and left in the foyer.
